

# 2022 Butterfield Scholarship Recipient Announced

Ms. Harris has a particular interest in sustainable and ethically-sourced fashion, a growing and increasingly important field, in addition to making fashion more accessible and inclusive for all. During the pandemic, when not practicing her design skills, she worked as a Covid tester. Ms. Harris has achieved the Duke of Edinburgh Silver Award.
